What are Supplemental Educational Services?

It is FREE tutoring paid by Orland Unified School District under the No Child Left Behind Act to help your child improve his or her reading and math skills.

Who is eligible for the free tutoring services?

Students who attend Program Improvement Schools in year two or more, whose families receive free or reduced lunch, and who need extra help, are eligible. If the number of eligible students exceeds the financial resources available, the lowest achieving students from low-income families will receive SES first.

Who will tutor my child?

Parents have the option to choose a tutor from a list of providers (companies to provide tutoring) that has been approved by the State Board of Education. Providers who have expressed interest in delivering services in our district are included in this form. Other providers may also be available. You may also visit the CA Department of Education's site at www.cde.ca.gov/ta/ac/ti/ap/sspsearch.asp for more information, or see the enclosed selection sheet.

Where will the tutoring take place?

The location of the tutoring depends on the service a parent selects. Please look on request form under each provider's listing for available locations.

When will Tutoring begin?

Most programs will begin early in the school year, or after second enrollment period.

Will transportation be available?

No. The school district is not able to offer transportation for tutoring services.

Need help choosing a tutor?

Please contact your child's teacher or principal if you need help choosing a tutor.

How do I enroll my child in the tutoring program?

If you are interested in free tutoring services for your son/daughter, please complete the attached request form and **return** it to your child's school office, **by January 25, 2010**.

Since funding is limited, all students applying may not be able to receive free tutoring. If student enrollment is greater than funding and space available, priority will be given to the lowest performing students qualifying for free and reduced meals.
