**A - G REQUIREMENTS**

A. History/Social Science	2 years	Civics World History U.S. History (or U.S. AP)
B. English	4 years	English I, II, III, IV (or English III A/P, IV A/P)
C. Mathematics	3 years required (Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II) (4 years recommended)	Algebra I Geometry Algebra II Math Analysis Calculus A/P
D. Laboratory Science	2 years required (Biology and Chemistry or Physics) (3 years recommended)	Biology Chemistry Anatomy/Physiology Physics
E. Language Other than English	2 years study in one language (3 years recommended)	Spanish I, II, III Spanish IV A/P
F. Visual & Performing Arts	1 year Art, Drama, or Music	Advanced Choir Advanced Band Art I Interior Design Drama

**ALL OF THE CLASSES LISTED ABOVE MUST BE PASSED WITH A GRADE C OR BETTER.**

Many universities, or specific majors or programs within a college or university, are becoming impacted (more students applying than there is room for). Therefore, students may need more than the minimum requirements to be accepted. For UC only, 7 of the 15 minimum A-G subject requirements must be completed during the 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grades.

[Class of 2012 and beyond: 11 of the 15 "A-G" courses must be completed by the end of the junior year.]

Testing Requirements:

1. CSU - ACT or SAT Reasoning                      UC - ACT with Writing or SAT Reasoning
2. UC only - SAT Subject Tests – in two different subjects areas (in addition to ACT with Writing or SAT Reasoning)  
(If student chooses to take the math subject test, UC accepts Math Level II only)  
[Class of 2012 and beyond: Subject Tests are not required but could be recommended for certain majors]
