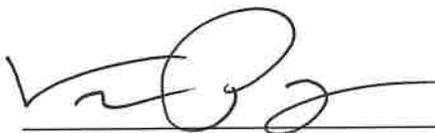
Trustee Reimers: Thanked the individuals who donated to the schools. Also thanked everyone who helped make the field trips possible.

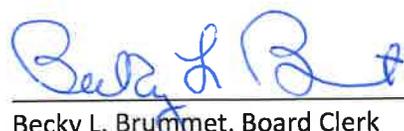
