interest loan with PG&E. We have a call on Friday with the project manager and will set up weekly project management calls. They will start replacing air conditioners in December.

Branding workshop – Earlier today, we had a workshop with a graphic artist to see about updating the district logo. We need to establish a subcommittee of the board to set up a process. Suzi & Erika volunteered to be on the committee which will meet on Nov 8<sup>th</sup> @ 1:00pm

Board Policy subcommittee – will meet on Monday November 6th @ 10:00 am

<u>FPM –</u> They will be here Dec 18, 19 & 20 – we will probably get findings, we will get them resolved.

<u>CSBA</u> – Came and did some filming and collecting of evidence around our summer program – They are preparing material and trying to get board workshops for districts to bring CSBA to talk about summer learning and the value of it. They want to engage with Orland for a day workshop on Nov 15<sup>th</sup> from 10-2.

<u>Teacher leadership around technology</u> – Sixteen teachers are participating. Teachers have gone to spend the day in Redding. Today they sent their coaches to work with our teachers. Hearing positive things from people involved. From this we will be able to select somebody to be the Ed Tech Coach and we will also need to develop a layer of teacher support.

- 6.2 <u>LCAP Update</u> There were some technical changes that we had to make. We didn't change any services or actions. We had to put in matrix that it met state requirements, for example our baseline data shows that we have zero dropouts in eighth grade and we will continue to have zero dropouts in eighth grade. We have to have four local indicators that we get to develop ourselves and it will be uploaded into the dashboard. Dr. Geisick went onto dashboard and showed what indicators have to be uploaded by December 1st. The board will have to approve in November.

We do send a letter to all kindergarteners at Lake, Plaza and Capay that are ours and remind them of their spot.
